RE: Equifax® Data Breach – What you need to know.

September 8, 2017

Equifax, a credit reporting agency, publicly disclosed a breach on September 7, 2017. The breach potentially impacts 143 million US consumers and was discovered on July 29, 2017. The incident appears to be limited to Equifax and a relatively small number of card numbers were compromised. Information included personal data, birth dates, credit card numbers, Social Security numbers and more. Here are some things members can do:

- ★ Go to www.equifaxsecurity2017.com to check whether you are one of the 143 million people whose data may have been compromised.
- ★ Set fraud alerts – all bureaus.
- ★ Monitor credit activity (www.annualcreditreport.com, etc.).
- ★ Reset account passwords, PIN codes and other log-in credentials on financial accounts that may be vulnerable.
- ★ Establish multiple-authentication protocols for financial accounts and email, when possible
- ★ Establish credit monitoring service through Equifax or through other service providers. Utilizing the Equifax credit monitoring service may affect your legal rights. The credit union does not endorse any particular credit monitoring service.
